Jianbing Yan Huazhong Agricultural University

Jianbing Yan is the vice president of Huazhong Agricultural University and a professor at the School of Plant Science and Technology, Huazhong Agricultural University. He is also the vice president of Crop Genetic Improvement, the chief scientist of Hongshan Laboratory, and the executive deputy director of the laboratory. Currently, he is mainly engaged in research on maize genomics and molecular breeding. He is currently serving as the executive director of the China Crop Society and the director of the Chinese Society of Plant Physiology and Molecular Biology.



Gucheng Li Huazhong Agricultural University

Gucheng Li is the Dean of College of Economics and Management of HZAU and a professor at the department of agricultural economics, is a member of the Presidium of Global Food Security Association for Young Scientists. His research focuses on agricultural production/technology economics, the oilseed rape industry economy and international trade of agricultural products. He has been recognized as one of the leading talents and young talents in philosophy and social sciences at the national level. He is also one of the "Four Batch" talents and a recipient of the "New Century Outstanding Talents" award from the Ministry of Education. He has published over 40 papers in journals such as Economics Quarterly, Management World, Food Policy, and the Australian Journal of Agricultural and Resource Economics.



### Prasanna Boddupalli CIMMYT

Prasanna Boddupalli is the Director of CIMMYT's Global Maize Program and the CGIAR Research Program on Maize (MAIZE). He has been at the forefront of effectively tackling the maize lethal necrosis (MLN) disease in eastern Africa. Additionally, Prasanna is technically coordinating CIMMYT-led multi-institutional and multi-disciplinary efforts in fighting the challenge of Fall Armyworm outbreak across Africa and Asia. With over three decades of experience in maize R&D, Prasanna has published over 140 research articles in reputable international journals, as well as over 50 book chapters and books. He has received several awards and honors for his contributions to maize research, excellence in post-graduate teaching, and human resource development.



### Channing Arndt IFPRI

Channing Arndt is the Senior Director for Transformation Strategies, where he oversees four units within IFPRI/CGIAR: Natural Resources and Resilience, Innovation Policy and Scaling, Foresight and Policy Modeling, and Development Strategies and Governance, which houses IFPRI's regional offices and country programs. He has worked closely with central decision-making organs at the national level in Africa and Asia, including six years of resident experience in the Ministry of Planning and Finance in Mozambique. He has dedicated his career to the systemic transformations that underpin inclusive and sustainable economic development, and established a reputation for building institutional capacity in countries and via research networks such as the African Economic Research Consortium.



### Thomas Glauben IAMO

Thomas Glauben is the Director of IAMO and Head of the Department of Agricultural Markets. Thomas is also a full professor at the Faculty of Natural Science III and a co-opted professor at the Law and Economics Faculty of Martin Luther University Halle-Wittenberg, Germany. From 2013 to 2015, Thomas was a member of the Presidium of the Leibniz Association. Currently, he is a member of the boards of various journals and trade publishers. Since 2007, Thomas has been an associate member of the REAP Center at Stanford University, USA.



### Máximo Torero FAO

Maximo Torero Cullen is the Chief Economist of the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO). He joined the Organization in January 2019 as Assistant Director-General for the Economic and Social Development Department. Prior to joining FAO, he was the World Bank Group Executive Director for Argentina, Bolivia, Chile Paraguay, Peru and Uruguay since November 2016 and before the Bank Torero led the Division of the Markets, Trade, and Institutions at the International Food Policy Research Institute. His major research work lies mostly in analyzing poverty, inequality, importance of geography and assets in explaining poverty, and in policies oriented towards poverty alleviation based on the role played by infrastructure, institutions, and on how technological breakthroughs can improve the welfare of households and small farmers.



Junfei Bai China Agricultural University

Junfei Bai is a Professor and Doctoral Supervisor at the School of Economics and Management, China Agricultural University. He is also the Chief Expert at the Beijing Food Safety Policy and Strategy Research Center and the Founder of the Center for Food and Health Economics Research (C'FHER) at the School of Economics and Management, China Agricultural University, where he serves as the first Executive Director. His main research areas include consumer and health economics, food safety and policy, and resource economics and sustainable development. He has led 5 key projects, general projects, and youth projects funded by the National Natural Science Foundation, as well as over 30 projects at the provincial and ministerial level, and international cooperative research projects.



Hang Xiong Huazhong Agricultural University

Hang Xiong is the Secretary-General of the Global Food Security Association for Young Scientists. He is a professor of Economics at the College of Economics and Management of HZAU and the Deputy Dean of the Macro Agriculture Research Institute. Prior to joining HZAU, Xiong was a research fellow at the Agricultural Economics and Policy Group in ETH Zurich and the Department of Geography at King's College London. His research interest focuses on understanding individuals' decision-making behavior and evaluating public policies using a social simulation approach. He has published papers in prestigious journals in the fields of social simulation and agricultural economics. He also serves on the editorial boards of three influential journals.



Xuecai Zhang CIMMYT

Xuecai Zhang is a senior research scientist working at the Global Maize Program of CIMMYT. He is one of the most committed and top-performing young scientists at CIMMYT, who has grown in his ability to lead and coordinate complex efforts as a strategic thinker in his early to mid-career at CIMMYT over the past twelve years. He has published more than 60 high-quality research articles in internationally highly reputed journals, including 20 publications as the first author or (co-) corresponding author.



### Zhanli Sun IAMO

Zhanli Sun has been working at IAMO since November 2008 as a scientist in the Department of Structural Change. He is also one of the coordinators of the International Research Group China. He studied cartography in college and received his doctorate in geography from the Chinese Academy of Sciences in 1999. His research focuses on land use change and he utilizes various analytical and simulation models, such as agent-based models, system dynamics, and Bayesian network. From 2002 to 2006, Zhanli Sun worked as a scientist at the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign in the USA, where he contributed to the development of the LEAM soil use simulation model. Jianbing Wang Wuhan Golden Huinong Ecological Agriculture Coopera




### Jude William Genilo University of Liberal Arts Bangladesh
